- **Approve Minutes:**

- **Questions on Updates:**
- **SOC Update:**
 - Alumni Student in crisis.
 - Add information about Kognito Training to the MMM. Training in Kognito is available until the end of December 2023.
- **eSports:**
 - Turn into a computer lab for students. New signage was placed stating no food no drink. Mel and Abby will work to promote within Library Learning Hub (LLH) and TRIO spaces.
 - IT will install Microsoft Products on eSport computers.
 - There is not currently a replacement schedule for student-use computers. Notify IT for student-use computers needed to be replaced or updated.
- **CARE Updates: 10-9-2023 through 10-13-2023**
 - No report submitted
- **Canva update (AR)**
 - Many employees have signed up for a Canva subscription. Canva has tiered pricing for a team of five people it is three hundred dollars per year. For a team of ten individuals, it will cost one thousand and fifty dollars, and for twenty-five individuals it is three thousand dollars. Pro and Team subscriptions are at the same pricing level in Canva.
 - Splitting purchases on software is not permissible, as it would be subverting the accessibility.
 - Abby will survey the campus to gauge interest and usage.
 - Accounts for software programs should not be using individual emails, but division emails.
 - Campus version has an LMS integration with Canvas.
- **Leave Policies Report (SB & KT):**
 - Waiting for information from OCHE.
- **Academic Calendar (SB):**

- No comments were received on the proposed calendar.
- One situation that was noted was the Cosmetology program hours. That program is operating Tuesday – Saturday, so specific calendar situations will need to be reviewed and addressed by Executive Director and faculty. This is a program that must maintain a specific number of hours.
- **NWCCU Standards Review: 1C3**
 - **1.C1:** Accredited programs systemically reviewed
 - Board requirement for programs to fulfill
 - Advisory boards discuss curriculum
 - Include consistent questions for all programs to ask and advisory boards about this regularly
 - Common Course Numbering and Pathways offer alignment with field for programs
 - Can improve how we decide when to terminate a program
 - APR is not great for this:
 - The need to eliminate may not coincide with the cycle
 - APRC needs work- faculty in the room or not?
 - Need conversation with and without faculty in the room for APRC and Cabinet
 - Faculty not likely to recommend term
 - Consider adding the status of probation with the required two-year check-in
 - New GE has strict criteria to help document the value of a program to students
 - All programs must report, only consequences for certificates
 - Deification of rigor built into the assessment, I, R, and M levels
 - **1C2:** Clarification, numbering is not officially used to determine a sequence of course
 - Educate campus on ASCRC, course numbering, and ASCRC report at the State of the Union
 - We are developed - In general increased our understanding of how ASCRC works
 - **1C3:**
 - LOs set by FLOC, HC modifies and tweaks
 - What do students want to see balanced with NWCCU requirements?
 - We write course descriptions for the most part – we can improve these to better explain the class
 - Should we have official LOs and plain language versions?
 - Looking into software for a more robust catalog and streamlined information
 - Publicized course bank -= statement in catalog directing to course bank for COLS
